
COLLAGE BOOK PROJECT

The Project:

Create a collage using pictures that represent important parts of the book.

The Details:

- Use a large poster board for your collage.
- Make sure the Title and author are displayed prominently on your collage.



On a separate piece of paper, write a descriptive title for each
picture that you included and at least two sentences about why it
was important to the book. For example, if you read one of the
tarry Potter books, you could include a picture of a lightning bolt
and write about why Harry has that mark on his forehead.

Tips for Success:

- ✓ As you read the book, keep a list of important characters, events, and objects to use in your collage.
- ✓ Remember that in a collage, pictures overlap a bit.
- ✓ Be sure the glue the edges and corners down carefully to make your collage look neat.
